



Official Rules and Information regarding the Raffle of the Montreal Canadiens Children's Foundation (RACJ License #10)

ELIGIBILITY:

- Participation is reserved exclusively to people who are 18 years of age or older and are physically located in the province of Quebec when purchasing tickets.
- The following individuals are not eligible to participate in the raffles: Montreal Canadiens Children's Foundation employees and volunteers assigned to the raffle, CH Group IT Department employees assigned to the activation of the raffle, employees of the company supplying the draw technology, and individuals serving on the Montreal Canadiens Children's Foundation Board of Directors, any person with whom these employees and individuals live and the immediate family of said employees and individuals.

HOW TO ENTER:

- Tickets are sold by volunteers during Montreal Canadiens games as well as through an online platform administered by employees of the Foundation.
- Ticket buyers who purchase in person at Montreal Canadiens games will receive their printed ticket listing their numbers associated with the purchased tickets. When purchased through online platform, ticket buyers receive a digital stub by email listing the numbers associated with the package purchased.
- The corresponding individual ticket numbers are collected simultaneously for the random number generator electronic winning ticket draw.
- Clients will be required to provide their contact information to participate.

DRAWING AND NOTIFICATION OF PRIZE WINNER:

- The winning ticket draw date and time for each raffle will be communicated on the Foundation's website and will be printed on the participant's ticket.
- The winning number and prizes will be announced on the Foundation's website following the draw. The winning number will also be announced on the central scoreboard at the Bell Centre during the 3rd period of the Montreal Canadiens game.
- In the event of a discrepancy between the announced (displayed) winning number and the official winning number, the latter shall prevail.
- The holder of the ticket containing the winning raffle number must claim their prize by contacting the Foundation by telephone or email, forwarding their purchase email (or present their printed ticket) and proof of identity. The holder of the winning ticket will have fourteen (14) business days from the time of the announcement to claim the prize. The Foundation will also use the contact information provided by the ticket purchaser to attempt to contact them.
- If the person holding the winning number selected does not claim their prize within the fourteen (14) business days period, the prize amount will be invested in a Montreal Canadiens Children's Foundation program approved by the *Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Québec*.
- The winner must complete a declaration and release form before taking possession of their prize.
- The 50/50 prize (winning prize) will consist in 50% of the total amount raised. In the event of a discrepancy between the announced (displayed) amount and the official amount raised, the latter shall prevail.
- 50/50 prize winnings will be paid by direct deposit in Canadian dollars, following receipt of banking information of the winner, within 60 business days following the raffle. In some cases, 50/50 prize winnings may be paid by cheque.
- The prize is not transferable and must be accepted as awarded with no substitutions.
- Only the holder of the winning ticket may claim the prize.

- The Montreal Canadiens Children’s Foundation shall have no responsibility regarding any other person who claims any interest or right to receive all or any part of the prize associated with a winning ticket.
- Chances of winning depend on the total number of tickets sold.
- Tickets are subject to verification by raffle organizers. All fraudulent tickets will automatically be removed from the draw and not give right to a prize. Unauthorized persons copying, selling or altering tickets are subject to prosecution. A raffle ticket will be void if there is proof that the ticket was stolen, not issued, ineligible, altered, counterfeit, defective, printed in duplicate, or printed/produced in error.
- In the event that a secondary prize is added to a raffle, the details of the prize, its value and draw details will be communicated on the Foundation’s website and will be printed on the participant’s ticket. All eligibility conditions, draw and notification to the prize winner information, other general conditions and publicity release listed in this document will apply.

OTHER GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- All ticket sales are final. There will be no refunds issued to anyone for any reason. All tickets purchased and for which the raffle numbers on those respective tickets are entered into the draw cannot be refunded, including if a ticket purchaser made an error in selecting the amount of tickets they desire to purchase.
- No official receipt for income tax purposes will be issued for the purchase of raffle tickets as set out by Canada Revenue Agency.
- If the integrity of the raffle is compromised in any way, the Foundation will notify the *Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Québec* (RACJ) and consult the RACJ on how to best move forward. The Foundation must receive RACJ approval prior to cancelling the raffle and/or modifying the raffle rules.
- The Montreal Canadiens Children’s Foundation, the Montreal Canadiens Hockey Club, the Bell Centre, l’Aréna des Canadiens, the Groupe CH and any presenting sponsors and partners of the raffle program will administer the program in good faith and in the best interests of the Foundation. None of the partners (nor any employee or representative of any of the foregoing) shall be liable at any time for any errors, system malfunctions or decisions made in connection with the administration of the program.
- All winners release the Foundation, its partners, employees, or any other agents from any responsibility for damages they may incur by accepting or using their prize.
- This raffle program is subjected to all applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations. The decisions rendered by the organizers are final and without appeal in all aspects of the said raffle.

PUBLICITY RELEASE

- By participation in the raffle, winners thereby grant the Montreal Canadiens Children’s Foundation (and its representatives) the right to print, publish or broadcast their name, portrait, picture, voice, likeness, and biographical information for any purpose related to the Foundation and its activities without any form of compensation, including but not limited to, advertising and promotional purposes.
